Section A must be completed in full: If owner is a body corporate, full registered name to be shown. If jointly owned, Joint Ownership Nomination form (MR186) must be completed.

Section B must be completed if vehicle licence duty is to be paid. Declaration of Purchaser must be made by the new owner. Vehicle licence duty at the prescribed rate is payable on the dutiable value (see reverse for definitions)

Section 1 Scope of Bulk Licensing Scheme

Permission to certify the accuracy of information submitted and the fitness of motor vehicles/trailers under the provisions of the *Road Traffic (Vehicle Standards) Regulations 2002* for licensing purposes without individual inspection of these vehicles at Examination Centres. Application applies only to approved firms and relevant only to standard stock models and those fitted with known optional equipment offered by the manufacturer and complying, in all aspects, with the Vehicle Standards Regulations. With the exception of an after-market tray fitted by an authorised installer (see Section 2), non-optional equipment, ie. kangaroo bars, wide wheels, exhaust equipment, additional fuel tanks, etc. MUST NOT be fitted to vehicles within this Scheme.

Section 2 Approved Installation of After-market Tray

If the vehicle referred to in this form is a cab-chassis utility and an after-market tray has been fitted by an authorised installer, the relevant declaration must be attached.

Section 3 Duties of Approved Certifying Officer

Certifying officer(s) - (senior officers of company or firm) must ensure that the vehicle referred to in this form has been thoroughly examined by a qualified automotive mechanic, or in the case of trailers a suitably qualified person, and has been found:

- : that the correct number plates and registration label have been attached to the vehicle.
- : to conform with the requirements of the Road Traffic (Vehicle Standards) Regulations 2002;
- : to be in roadworthy condition;
- : that all details shown are accurate;

Section 4

Refund of fees pertaining to the cancellation of a vehicle licence granted under the Bulk Licensing Scheme will be subject to approval by the Director General.

Section 5 Discretion of Director, Customer Services

Should it appear to the Director, Customer Services that through errors, laxity or any other reason, the conditions under which any permit is granted are not strictly adhered to, the Director, Customer Services may, at the Director, Customer Services discretion, cancel the authority of any nominated personnel or the Bulk Licensing permit on issue.

DEFINITIONS

Under the provisions of the Duties Act 2008:

- "Purchase Price", in relation to a vehicle, includes any amount
 - (a) allowed by the seller on a trade-in or an exchange of any article;
 - (b) paid to the seller for anything included with or incorporated into the vehicle; or
 - (c) paid to the seller for the preparation of the vehicle for delivery to the purchaser.

"Dutiable Value", in relation to a new vehicle, means the price fixed by the manufacturer, importer or principal distributor as the retail selling price in Western Australia of a vehicle of that make and model.

Note: Dutiable Value DOES NOT include any special discount offered to the purchaser (fleet owner's discount, sales tax exemption).

Approved Immobiliser

An approved immobiliser means an immobiliser fitted by the manufacturer or an immobiliser approved under the Vehicle Engine Immobiliser Scheme. For details of approved immobilisers visit www.transport.wa.gov.au/licensing or contact the Department of Transport on 13 11 56.
